How to use mixed medium while using the strong building blocks of foundation drawing skills. Learn about expressing your creative ability.

Some of these skills will be - composition, measuring, perspective, colour and tone.

With a mixture of mediums such as charcoal, pencil, pastel – soft, hard and oil, acrylic and water-colour paint, collage and some print making techniques. You will explore different techniques while learning about the makeup of these materials and why and how they work together and why some just don't work.

Some subjects covered will be, landscape, portrait and the human body, animals, still life, interiors and moving objects.

Above all come along for the ride and have some fun while learning a new way to look at both formal and expressive drawing.

START UP MATERIALS

2B and 4B drawing pencils

coloured pencils (small box)

willow and compressed charcoal

pastels whatever you have

A2 and A1 drawing paper 150 – 250g

eraser 1 hard and 1 putty
